Classroom Behaviour Monthly Focus[~] Zones of Regulation[~] http://www.zonesofregulation.com.

This month we are focusing on the "Zones of Regulation," a system that sorts emotions into colours and helps students self-regulate their behaviour. Here is an abbreviated list for you to refer to, should your child announce at home that they are in the blue/red/green/yellow zone.

BLUE- (We say "zoned out") Tired, sick, bored.

GREEN- (We say "good to go!") Focused, feeling OK, ready to learn. YELLOW- (We say "getting stressed") Worried, anxious, silly, stressed, excited.

RED- (We say "Lost it") Mad, angry, mean, terrified, yelling, out of control.

We will also be practicing strategies for helping move from one zone, back to the Green Zone. ©
